For All the Saints

Another hymn we used to sing at school if you are, like me, "of a certain age!"

The 1st of November is remembered in some traditions as All Saints Day. It begins a season of remembrance. For many, it calls to mind saints who have gone before us and now as the hymn put it "from their labours rest."

Baptist tend to prefer the notion that we are all saints, "holy people" which is the original meaning of the word.

We are holy because we have put our trust in Jesus and he makes us holy, that is, people who belong to God.

Nevertheless, there are heroes that we look to,people who have gone before us and left a light for us to follow. Some of them are well known but many of them are not and probably had no idea about the impact they made in the world for Jesus sake. I think of my earliest Sunday school teachers who told me about Jesus and taught me to pray. I think of my girls brigade captain val who forgave my sometimes difficult teenage behaviour. I think of youth workers and church

So for all the Saints militant or triumphant I give thanks and pray that we will also pass on the light to people who come behind us. With the Holy Spirit's help our loving acts and words may have outcomes we can't imagine.

Church Officers (annual appointments):
